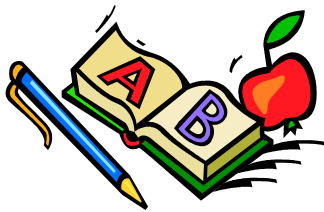

Campbellsville Christian Church Center for Education Registration

Registration for the 2018 – 2019 school year is underway. Registration priority is given to members of CCC, children of CCCCFE staff, and students already enrolled in the school. Registration includes completing and returning registration packets, along with payment of the supply fee, book fees and 1 week of tuition. Registrations for the up-coming school year will be taken as follows:

January - Church members and CCCCFE staff have first priority and can stop by the main office to register in January. Church members not registering in January will be registered along with all others, in the order that registrations and fees are returned.

February - Students already enrolled in the school will be asked to register in February.

March – Children whose parents have filled out a student application, but who are not already enrolled in the school will be contacted and asked to register in March.

Parents are encouraged to respond promptly. When registration begins in February for returning students, classes will fill up quickly. When a class is full, children will be placed on a waiting list. As a vacancy in that class arises, the family will be notified.
